Summary

This position operates the pans and associated equipment in a safe and efficient manner to produce quality white sugar and to achieve sugar end objectives as directed by management

Essential Job Duties

- The Sugar Boiler operates the white pans and associated equipment to produce quality white sugar as directed, safely, efficiently, and in compliance with all food safety rules and regulations.
- The Sugar Boiler must understand and apply their knowledge of the following and any related equipment:
 - ▶ Safety, food safety, and sanitation rules
 - ▶ Quality control specifications
 - ▶ Vacuum pans, both batch and continuous
 - ▶ Crystallization theory and practical application
 - ▶ Steam, vapor, and condensate theory and systems
 - ▶ Sugar end management
 - ▶ Associated systems, including, but not limited to, filters, melters, remelt sugar operations, centrifugals, crystallizers, and sugar drying, cooling, screening, and storage.
 - ▶ Instrument and laboratory data
- Assure that all work areas are kept clean within the food safety and sanitation guidelines.
- Complete reports as required.
- Develop the process and mechanical skills of self and others through training.
- Use people, time, equipment, and material in the most efficient manner.
- Report mechanical, electrical, instrumentation, environmental, food safety, feed safety, and operational problems, and unsafe conditions to supervisor.
- Other duties as required by the business.
- Adhere to all company policies and all safety, food safety, feed safety, and sanitation rules and programs
